7 J.Haydn: 1st movement of Cello Concerto of your choice.

For 5, the original version (The Packard Humanities Institute) must be used.

Eulenberg and Breitkopf versions are also acceptable.

For 6, Gruetzmacher's version in B flat major is not acceptable.

For 7, Henle's or Schott's version should be used.

[Secondary qualifying]

From A and B, select one piece, respectively.

 - 1 L.v. Beethoven: Cello Sonata No.3 in A major, Op.69 1st and Final movement.
 - 2 F.Schubert: Arpeggione Sonata in A minor, 1st and Final movement.
 - 3 F.Mendelssohn: Cello Sonata No.1 in B flat Major, Op.45,1st and Final movement.
 - 4 F.Chopin: Cello Sonata in G minor, Op65, 1st and Final movement.
 - 5 J.Brahms: Cello Sonata No 1 in G minor, Op.38,1st and Final movement.

Note: omit repetitions except for the last movement of 2.

- B. From the following, select one piece.
 - 6 M.Reger: Suite for Solo Cello No.1 in G major, Op.131c 1st and Final movement.
 - 7 M.Reger: Suite for Solo Cello No.2 in D minor, Op.131c 1st and Final movement.
 - 8 M.Reger: Suite for Solo Cello No.3 in A minor, Op.131c 3rd movement.
 - 9 P.Hindemith: Sonata for Solo Cello, Op.25-3
 - 10 Z.Kodaly: Sonata for Solo Cello, Op.8 1st movement.
 - 11 E.Ysaye: Sonata for Solo Cello, Op.28 1st and 2nd movement.
 - 12 G.Crumb: Sonata for Solo Cello
